- Outline** The Under 21 Slam was introduced to revitalise and raise the profile of current Under 21 Competitions and attract international teams. The Under 21 Slam is being administered by the RCCC in conjunction with the local organising committees. Separate male and female competitions will be run within each event and points will be awarded to the top eight male teams and top four female teams.
- Eligibility**
- Teams must be all male or all female.
  - All team members must be less than 21 years of age by the end of the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June 2017.
  - All team members must be members of the RCCC, with exception of international entries.
- Competitions**
- Greenacres Junior Masters - 15-17<sup>th</sup> September 2017** (12 Male / 12 Female Teams)  
**Kinross Junior Classic - 29<sup>th</sup> September - 1<sup>st</sup> October 2017** (12 Male / 8 Female Teams)  
**Inverness Junior International - 10-12<sup>th</sup> November 2017** (12 Male / 8 Female Teams)  
**Lockerbie Junior Invitation - 15-17<sup>th</sup> December 2017** (10 Male / 10 Female Teams)
- Please note points will be awarded from the Scottish Curling Junior Championships (24-28<sup>th</sup> January 2018) see prizes details.
- Entry Fees** £120 per team per competition (apart from the Scottish Curling Junior Championships)
- Payment can be made by cheque, over the phone or by bank transfer (BACS). When paying by bank transfer, you must reference the team name and the competition

#### Competition Rules

- Format (excl playoffs) will be determined by each organising committee.
- In order to continue accruing points on Asham Under 21 Slam Leaderboard, no more than six players may be used by one team in any given season.
- On use of 7th player in any tournament, points awarded in that event will be listed as a new team on the Asham Under 21 Slam Leaderboard.
- Additional points only will be accrued from the Scottish Curling Junior Championships.

#### Points

##### Junior Men

- 1st = 15 points
- 2nd = 11 points
- 3rd = 9 points
- 4th = 7 points
- 5th - 8th = 5 points

##### Junior Women

- 1st = 15 points
- 2nd = 11 points
- 3rd = 9 points
- 4th = 7 points

The leaderboard will be updated after each event.

#### Prizes

- **£1000** will be awarded to the overall top male and female teams.
- Prizes will be provided by the host rink at each event for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in male and female events.
- Asham product for each slam competition winner.
- As part of the Academy programme and an incentive to the slam, this season we are introducing additional prizes/entries into competitions.

The structure is as follows:

1. **After the 1<sup>st</sup> Asham Under 21 Slam** = Entry, travel & accommodation for one men & women's team into EJCT competition.
2. **After 3 Asham Under 21 Slams** = Competition entry for the top two men & women's teams.
3. **After 4 Asham Under 21 Slams + Scottish Junior Championships** = Competition entry for the top two men & women's teams.

*Points 1-3 above are to be agreed and arranged with RCCC Performance Development Coach.*
