Outline RCCC Affiliated Clubs can enter 1 or 2 teams to compete for a District Medal against a club in the same district, where possible. The matches will be determined by the locality of an ice rink.

The winning Club should submit their scorecard to the RCCC to claim their medal.

Eligibility All team members must be members of the RCCC.

Date and Venue The first named team shall organise the match at their local ice rink on a date suitable for both clubs.

Entry Fees £12 to RCCC and ice fees at venue.

Payment can be made by cheque, over the phone or by bank transfer (BACS). When paying by bank transfer, you must reference the team name and the competition
