### **Outline**

The Scottish Curling Junior Men's Championship is the pinnacle Men's Junior event in Scotland with teams competing for the title and the right to represent Scotland in the World Curling Championships (Curl Aberdeen, Scotland) - 3<sup>rd</sup> March to 10<sup>th</sup> March 2018.

The Championship may be in two stages:

- Qualifiers Dewars Centre (Perth) if required.
- Championship Curl Aberdeen

### Eligibility

- Teams must be male.
- All team members must be members of the RCCC.
- All team members must be less than 21 years of age by the end of the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June 2017
- All team members must be eligible to represent Scotland subject to Rule C12 International Representation.

Date

Qualifier - Friday 1<sup>st</sup> to Sunday to 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2017 if required. Championship - Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> to Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> January 2018.

**Entry Fees** 

Qualifier - £120 per team, if required.

Championships - £200 per team (or an additional £80 if no qualifier was required)

Payment can be made by cheque, over the phone or by bank transfer (BACS). When paying by bank transfer, you must reference the team name and the competition
