

Scottish Curling Junior Women's Championship 2017-2018 Entry Form



- Outline** The Scottish Curling Junior Women's Championship is the pinnacle Women's Junior event in Scotland with teams competing for the title and the right to potentially represent Scotland in the World Curling Championships (Curl Aberdeen, Scotland) - 3rd March to 10th March 2018.
- The Championship may be in two stages:
- Qualifiers - Dewars Centre (Perth) if required.
 - Championship - Curl Aberdeen
- Eligibility**
- Teams must be female.
 - All team members must be members of the RCCC.
 - All team members must be less than 21 years of age by the end of the 30th day of June 2017.
 - All team members must be eligible to represent Scotland subject to Rule C12 International Representation.
- Date** Qualifier - Friday 1st to Sunday 3rd December 2017 if required.
Championship - Tuesday 24th to Sunday 28th January 2018
- Entry Fees** Qualifier - £120 per team, if required.
Championships - £200 per team (or an additional £80 if no qualifier was required)
- Payment can be made by cheque, over the phone or by bank transfer (BACS). When paying by bank transfer, you must reference the team name and the competition

- Closing Date** 31st July 2017.
